Jamborall Overnights

Saturday 11:30am – Sunday 8:00am
\$20.00 per person

Cub Scout and parent park at the NPS Kendall Lake parking area, gather their tent and their camping gear and ride a shuttle bus to Camp Butler where they'll set up their overnight campsite. Campers will then hike to the Cub Scout Program Area at Camp Manatoc.
Participate in: Cub Program Activities, dinner, visit the displays at the Big Top, retreat, 100th anniversary Arena Show, fireworks and camp overnight. This activity requires a 1 adult per 1 scout ratio.
Fee includes: T-shirt, patch, all activities, dinner and campsite.

Participants arrive at NPS Virginia Kendall Quick Road parking area and ride bus to Camp Manatoc Dining Hall.
Participate in: Cub Program Activities, dinner, visit the displays at the Big Top, retreat, 100th anniversary Arena Show and fireworks. This activity requires a 1 adult per 3 scout ratio. No scout will be checked in without the assigned adult with them!
Fee includes: Patch, all activities and dinner.

Absolutely no walk-ins permitted.

Saturday Program highlights at Camp Manatoc

The heart of the Jamborall will be the Saturday program beginning with Scouting activities during the day, and ending with fireworks at the Arena Show. ALL program activities will occur at Camp Manatoc.

Overnighters will be departing Camp Butler by 2:00pm and will not return until after the Saturday evening 100th Anniversary Show and fireworks around 10:30 pm. Your picnic-style evening meal will be served in the Cub Program Area. Following the Big Top you will participate in the camp-wide retreat at Butler Memorial. The 100th Anniversary Arena Show will conclude the celebration. Each adult should bring a daypack along with a water bottle. Each person should also bring a small flashlight to help guide him or herself back to their campsite after the Arena Show. Full field uniform should be worn for retreat and the arena show. If you wear an activity T-shirt during the day, pack a uniform shirt in your daypack.

Registration -

Overnighters - Register at Camp Butler Administration Building when you arrive, before setting up camp. You will receive your nametag, t-shirt, patch, schedule and map. When you arrive at Camp Manatoc, you will proceed directly to the Cub Area, no other check in is required.

Day Trippers – Register at Camp Manatoc Dining Hall. You will receive a nametag, patch, schedule and map.

Cub Scout Activities – will take place in the dam spillway area of Lake Litchfield. Follow the map from the Dining Hall to the Lake and see how many “/SPY” - *Indian signs* you can find. 8 Activity areas will keep your Cub Scout busy for 3 hours, make sure you visit them all.

Dinner – Hot dog, chips, cookie, fruit and drink
